Texas Creative Curriculum (TXCC) Focus:

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle Mini Study

Mathematics: 100 Day Pattern: Black and white ovals, numbers 44-46.

Activities: Pollution bottle experiment, sorting recycling vs. trash, trash walk, puzzles, counting amounts, and measuring and comparing

Discussion and Shared Writing: Our discussion questions will ask students what they know about recycling, reducing, and reusing materials and what we want to find out, and how we can reduce the amount of paper towels we use in our classroom.

You can **foster independence and personal responsibility** by encouraging your child to:
*walk without being carried *carry his/her own backpack (redistribute weight by taking out lunchboxes/ other items to be carried separately) *practice opening lunch box and food packages (it's okay to struggle a little)
*clean up spills and messes during mealtimes

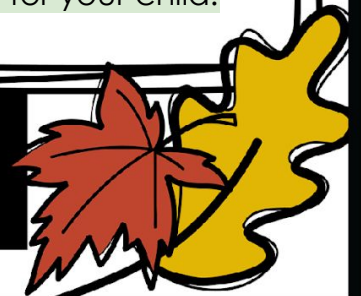

Create a Book Fair e-Wallet for your child!



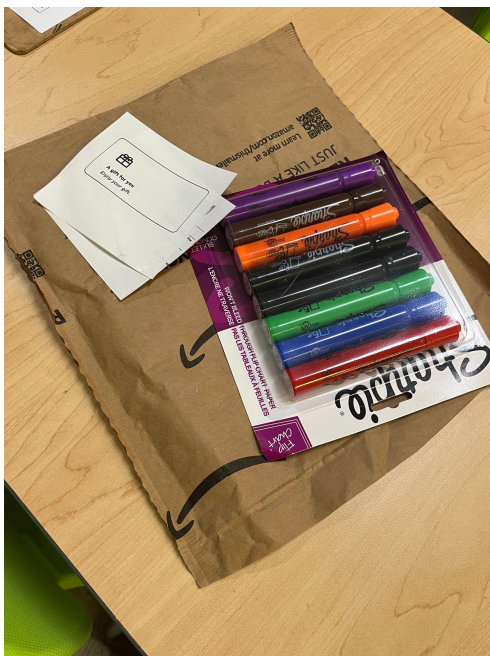
