Texas Creative Curriculum (TXCC) Focus: Wheels

Activities: Identifying numerals, understanding location words, recognizing rhyming words, rolls/does not roll chart, fine motor art

Interest Areas: Garage/mechanic play, red ribbon week/wheel/vehicle coloring pages, books about wheels/transportation, toy vehicles with road and ramps, wheel collection observations, playdough monsters, wheel tracks in playdough, songs about vehicles/wheels.

You can **foster independence and personal responsibility** by **allowing your child to struggle**. Children learn that they **can do hard things** when they are given the time, space, and encouragement to try. Modeling and being a cheerleader for your child can help them without you doing it for them. You can also explain that you will help after they have tried at least three times!
