CLASSROOM NEWS

Texas Creative Curriculum (TXCC) Focus: Wheels: Vehicles with Wheels

Alphabet Knowledge: Forming Letters: We will be learning how to form and write uppercase letters using the terminology "big line, little line, big curve, and little curve." We will learn that we form letters from the top to the bottom and from left to right. Students will compare letters and discuss similarities and differences, beginning with **L, F, E, H, T**

Heggerty: Week 12

Juan Pablo Skills: Getting the teacher's attention appropriately: *When we want the teacher's attention, we raise our hands*

Mathematics: 100 Day Pattern: brown and blue rhombus, numbers 57-61.

Books: Wheels on the Go! Alphabet Trucks A-Z, Freight Train, My Car, School Bus

Activities: patterns, counting and comparing (vehicles with and without wheels), ramp experiments, graphing (# of wheels), student learning goal assessments (shape, color, number, feelings identification and counting)

You can **foster independence and personal responsibility** by teaching your child to dress and undress independently, including putting on shoes and orienting clothing correctly. Additionally, learning **delayed gratification** is important. You can use "**first, then**" to help your child learn to wait for/earn wanted items/activities. For example, "First put your toys away, then you can play outside."

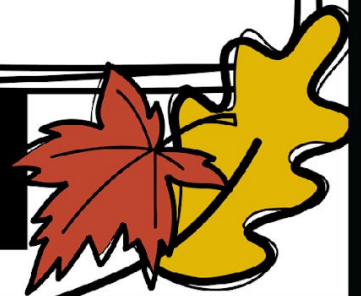
