COURSE DESCRIPTION

THIS COURSE IS DESIGNED TO INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO THE PRINCIPLES AND ELEMENTS INVOLVED IN CREATING ARRANGEMENTS IN THE FLORICULTURE INDUSTRY. TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: FLORAL DESIGN HISTORY, DESIGN PRINCIPLES AND ELEMENTS, FLORAL DESIGN PROCESS AND TECHNIQUES, IDENTIFICATION OF PLANT MATERIAL, FLORAL DESIGN TOOLS AND MECHANICS, CARE AND HANDLING OF CUT FLOWERS AND FOLIAGE, SHAPES OF FLORAL DESIGNS, USE OF EVERLASTING FLOWERS, AND SPECIAL OCCASION AND SEASONAL DESIGNS. STUDENTS WILL HAVE MANY HANDS-ON PROJECTS THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE COURSE, INCLUDING SEVERAL ARRANGEMENTS WITH LIVE CUT FLOWERS AND OTHER CRAFT DESIGNS.

- BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (COMPUTER, IPAD, ETC)

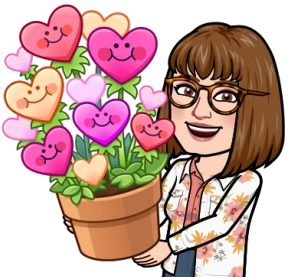
